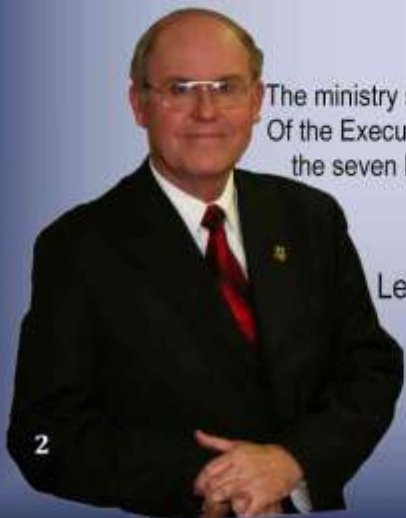

- 700 Hispanic Churches
- 100 African-American Churches
- 100 Other ethnic Churches

EXPRESSION: AFRICAN AMERICAN MINISTRIES

The primary focus will be three-fold: We will first have African American representation (reflective of demographic make-up) wherever there is an International Pentecostal Holiness Church presence. Secondly, we will determine the most effective method to address the needs of the African Americans through the perspective of the ministries which currently serve in their communities; and finally, determine how to best minister to the identified needs.

We will establish an African American Advisory Board, with a quorum of members from various geographic locations throughout the country. In an effort to build relationships, we will facilitate events in which African American pastors and leaders would come together for fellowship and worship.

Expanding "The Kingdom" within the African American Community through the influence of the IPHC Ministry by engaging, equipping and edifying African American Ministries and Ministry Leaders.

We will promote racial diversity and acceptance through education and training. We will develop and promote programs and training for racial diversity and unity between African American congregations and the community. We will educate African American Ministries and Ministry Leaders on the International Pentecostal Holiness Church ministries currently available to them.

Quadrennium Goals:

To reach 100 African American Churches across the IPHC in America. This would be defined by churches that have an African American Pastor and a majority of African American congregants.

It is the desire and intent of African American Ministries to come alongside the Local Church and Conference Leadership to more effectively reach this populace of our Nation.

As a reflection of our Vision Statement and in our endeavor to multiply Churches, our primary focus is three-fold. We will use what will be termed the **M.A.P.** model... **Mothering/Adopting/Planting**. This model will serve as a vehicle to encourage established Churches to daughter new congregations, promote Church adoption on the Conference level, and aggressively promote the planting of new Churches. For existing established Churches desiring to daughter new congregations, training will be provided to aid the mother Church in this endeavor as she provides oversight, guidance, nurturing and resourcing to the daughter Church.

Given the number of independent ministries and congregations desiring a spiritual covering, we will promote the IPHC Church Affiliate philosophy by encouraging Conference Bishops and Conference Evangelism Directors to engage existing independent ministries and congregations cultivating relationships and fellowship. Flexibility and innovation will be paramount as we increase the Kingdom of God and expand the IPHC influence through this networking effort.

We encourage Conferences to have Church planting as a ministry focus. In doing so, we will also challenge them to identify Church planters and partner with them in equipping the Church planter for success.

EXPRESSION: INE-INSTITUTO NACIONAL DE ENTRENAMIENTO



The vision to create a national training program for the Hispanic leadership of the IPHC was given to Dr. Ronald Carpenter, while serving as Director of EVUSA. Through prayer and careful planning it was identified as NTI (National Training Institute). The first site of the NTI Program was in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma in the year 2000. The NTI program was originally structured to train the Conference leadership. The first year 47 students were enrolled; the training was held at a local hotel in downtown Oklahoma City. The NTI program name was changed in 2003 to INE (Instituto Nacional de Entrenamiento) which is the Spanish translation. At the beginning of 2008 the INE program consisted of 13 sites, 23 teachers and over 800 student enrollment. Some of the courses offered are "16 Principles to Evangelism; Teaching to Change Lives"; Theology I, II and III".

The INE Program consists of two levels: INE Satellite and INE Leadership. INE Satellite is offered at local sites and consists of 12 courses over a two or three year period. Each weekend module begins on Friday evening and last all day Saturday. The program is available to any local church laity that would like to prepare for personal ministry.

The INE Leadership is for those individuals who have finished the INE Satellite program and want to prepare to assist in local Church leadership or plant a new Church. Some of the courses offered are "The Spirit of Leadership," "The Church Sent Forth," "Cell Groups" and other Church growth courses. We will be having training sites in the East, Central and West regions of the Nation.

The INE program is one of the tools God has given the IPHC to prepare future Hispanic leaders for the end time harvest. To God be the Glory for what He is doing through the INE program and its staff.

Stacy D. Hilliard is a native of St. Louis, Missouri and Hazlehurst, Mississippi. He is the founding pastor of Breakthrough Revival Center Church, Inc., where he has served for more than a decade and made Greenville, N.C. his home. He and his wife, Bobbie, have two daughters, Hannah and Phoebe. In keeping with his desire to serve the Lord with no inhibition, his ministry is one of reconstruction and spiritual reconciliation. His desire is that all people of God move into the true application of Jesus and serve Him through obedience and submission to God's Will. Through his dedication to the truth in salvation, his teaching serves to ignite the hunger and thirst for righteousness which God honors in man. Pastor Hilliard united with the International Pentecostal Holiness Church in February 2006. In March 2007, the North Carolina Conference Board appointed him to serve in the position of African American Coordinator. He also served as a member of the Bishop's Advisory Council with concurrent service on the Evangelism and Missions Board of the North Carolina Conference. In August 2009, Pastor Hilliard was elected to serve on the North Carolina Conference Board and was the first African American elected as a North Carolina Board member.

Hugh Holmes Morgan is a native of Birmingham, Alabama. It was there in 1952, that Hugh accepted a call to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. He enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 1953, and was a member of the Marine Band, Quantico, Virginia. After completing his enlistment in 1956, with the rank of Sergeant, he attended Furman University, graduating in 1960, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology. In 1960, the Pentecostal Holiness Church ordained him. He received a Master of Divinity degree from Asbury Theological Seminary in 1963, and an honorary Doctor of Divinity Degree from Holmes Theological Seminary, in 1975.
